Nothing should go into a stormwater intake except pure, clean rainwater runoff.

- Help keep our streets clean and litter free
- Do not rake leaves into stormwater intakes
- Do not pour used motor oil or other contaminants into the stormwater system

Henderson's stormwater flows in underground culverts, open ditches and creeks, and eventually finds its way to the Ohio River. Clean stormwater runoff helps protect aquatic life, and helps make our drinking water cleaner and safer too.
